Notice of behaviour support practitioners employed or engaged by specialist behaviour support providers

Section 29(3)(a) of the *National Disability Insurance Scheme (Restrictive Practices and Behaviour Support) Rules 2018*

Important information

There are special arrangements for NDIS providers transitioning to registration with the NDIS Quality and Safeguards Commission (NDIS Commission). *The National Disability Insurance Scheme (Restrictive Practices and Behaviour Support) Rules 2018* (NDIS Rules) require providers who are registered to deliver specialist behaviour support services to engage behaviour support practitioners who are considered 'suitable' by the NDIS Quality and Safeguards Commissioner.

A transitional approach will be used to support providers and behaviour support practitioners to understand and implement these new arrangements.

From 1 July 2018 the NDIS Commissioner may consider behaviour support practitioners as suitable for a period of time, pending assessment against a behaviour support practitioner competency framework (currently being developed).

Instructions

This form is to be used to provide the NDIS Commissioner with details of behaviour support practitioners in accordance with paragraph 29(3)(a) of the *National Disability Insurance Scheme (Restrictive Practices and Behaviour Support) Rules 2018*.

It applies to practitioners delivering services to participants residing in New South Wales and South Australia.

A survey was previously sent out to providers of Specialist Behaviour Support services in NSW and SA. If you have already responded to the survey, you do not need to complete this form.
